The abstract title is centered and written in 14-point bold font. Authors are grouped by affiliation, as shown above, with author names in 12-point font and affiliations in 10-point font. Please provide the e-mail address of the contact author, as shown.



Figure 1. Figures and figure captions are centered on the page.

Figures, such as Fig. 1, and graphs should be embedded in-line (do not use text boxes when submitting Word files). Figure captions are centered below the figures, using 10-point font. Include scale bars on all micrographs. Table captions should be centered above tables, using separate numbering (Table 1, Table 2, etc.). Please make sure graphs and figures are properly legible in black-and-white reproduction. Color figures will be available on-line only.

Submission of postscript or pdf files is preferred but Word (doc, docx) and OpenOffice (odt) files will also be accepted. We look forward to see you at the meeting.
